FOR THIRD WARD DEMOCRATS: PETITION SEASON IS UPON US It is that time of year again, when in order to run, candidates must collect petition signatures from members of their parties. This year, Tim Julian, your Democrat County Legislator, and I are working together to collect signatures. Rather than knocking on your door in Winter in the middle of a pandemic, we are setting ourselves up at The Other Side, the Gallery next to Cafe Domenico. Any Democrat registered to vote in the Third Ward is welcome to drop in and sign our petitions. We will have a safe and sanitary set up so that you can sign in a warm, safe space knowing that you are helping us secure our spots on the ballot, but doing so safely. Here are the days and times:

March 2, 3, 4, 5, from 4-7pm and March 5 & 6 11am-2pm After the week is over, we will judge whether we need to set up again the following week and let you know. Please come down, let's get this done!

We absolutely need your signatures in order to be on the ballot!

PUBLIC COMMENT IS POSSIBLE

While the public cannot join us in Council Chambers, it is nonetheless easy to participate in Public Comment: simply email the Clerk no later than 3pm on the day of the Common Council meeting. (She will place you on the list, and you will then get an email back with instructions on how to call in to the meeting.) You can email the Clerk at cityclerk@cityofutica.com. As of the next meeting, on Wednesday, March 3rd, the Council meetings will be held back in our Chambers.

Remember all meetings of the Council are live streamed on the <u>City's YouTube</u> <u>channel</u>, and I encourage you to watch our meetings from home. And all of the legislation under consideration is <u>available online at this link</u>. I will not hold regular Constituent Hours in March because I will be too busy using that regular time to collect petition signatures so that I can be on the ballot in the Fall. But come April, I will return to my regular schedule.
